**PURPOSE**

To submit to Council the upper limits of salaries, allowances and benefits of different members of the Municipal Council as per Government Gazette No 28990, dated 30 June 2006.

**PROPOSAL BY THE EXECUTIVE MAYOR**

1. That the allowances and benefits of different members of the Municipal Council be implemented with effect from 8 March 2006, according to Government Gazette No 28990, dated 30 June 2006.
2. That the Council Resolution dated 18 July 2006 regarding the matter be forwarded to the MEC of Local Government and Housing for concurrence.

**PROPOSAL BY COUNCILLOR (DR) JS MARAIS**

That the proposed increase of allowances and benefits not be implemented but that the current status quo be maintained.
